CONFLICT OF INTEREST STATEMENT

Authors are responsible for disclosing all financial and personal relationships that might bias their work. Financial relationships (such as employment, consultancies, stock ownership, honoraria, paid expert testimony) are the most easily identifiable conflicts of interest and the most likely to undermine the credibility of the journal.

To prevent ambiguity, authors must state explicitly in the letter accompanying the submitted manuscript whether potential conflicts do or do not exist. In the circumstance where there is a conflict it is to be explicitly stated under a heading **Conflict of interest**.

Otherwise, authors are required to include the following above the Abstract.

“Conflict of interest

The author/s of this paper declare/s no conflict of interest.”

Disclaimer

Facts and opinions published in the Journal of Health, Safety and Environment express solely the opinions of the respective authors. Authors are responsible for their citing of sources and the accuracy of their references and bibliographies. The editors cannot be held responsible for any lacks or possible violations of third parties' rights.

Funding

Authors must include a statement at the conclusion of the paper that identifies any funding sources for their work. This will be removed for anonymous peer review but re-inserted for publication.

Risk assessment

Authors must include a statement in the Methods section of compliance to any risk assessment procedures required by their organisations.
