# UNCW Men's Basketball NCAA Tournament History

## 2000 NCAA First Round Cincinnati 64, UNCW 47 • March 17, 2000 Gaylord Entertainment Center • Nashville, Tenn.

Sparked by a veteran front line and a spectacular rookie, UNCW swept to its first CAA championship and inaugural NCAA Tournament appearance in 1999-00.

The Seahawks were picked to finish near the bottom of the CAA, but a gritty group of players and a determined coaching staff produced a remarkable success story.

The road to the NCAA Tournament began in late November with a difficult loss at Wisconsin-Green Bay, but the resilient Seahawks bounced back three days later to hand Butler a 56-54 setback at Trask Coliseum.

With Jerry Wainwright pulling the strings, UNCW jelled in January by winning four of its last five games in the month and picking up steam for the stretch run.

Rallying with a stingy defensive unit, the Seahawks frustrated several opponents in the final month of the campaign. On Feb. 7, 2000, UNCW held James Madison to school-record lows for points and field goal shooting in a 57-32 throttling. Twelve days later, the Seahawks turned up the heat again in a 59-53 decision over George Mason.

When March rolled around and the CAA Tournament arrived, UNCW took the Cinderella crown and ran with it. The Seahawks turned back VCU in the quarterfinals, upset GMU in the semifinals and limited Richmond to 18 second-half points to claim their first league title.

UNCW made its NCAA Tournament debut against Cincinnati in the South Regional in Nashville and fell, 64-47, as the Bearcats broke away late in the second period at the Gaylord Entertainment Center in the Music City.

## 2002 NCAA First Round UNCW 93, Southern Cal 89 (OT) • March 14, 2002 ARCO Arena • Sacramento, Calif.

## 2003 NCAA First Round Maryland 75, UNCW 73 • March 21, 2003 Gaylord Entertainment Center • Nashville, Tenn.

A pair of talented seniors combined with a young supporting cast to produce one of the most memorable seasons in Seahawk basketball history as the 2002-2003 club successfully defended its CAA championship and came within an eye-lash of advancing to the NCAA's Round of 32 for the second consecutive year.

Seniors Brett Blizzard and Craig Callahan capped their storied careers in style. Blizzard, the CAA Player-of-the-Year, set numerous records and became the first player in the league's history to be named First-Team All-Conference for consecutive seasons.

Coach Brad Brownell's team opened the season in Lubbock, Texas, where it faced legendary coach Bob Knight's Texas Tech squad. The Seahawks then proved dominant during the conference season, going 15-3 overall and carrying a six-game winning streak into the CAA Tournament.

Led by Blizzard, the reliable Callahan and unflappable freshman John Goldsberry, UNCW won 12 of its last 14 games in the regular season and swept through the CAA Tourney.

The Seahawks knocked off Hofstra, Delaware and Drexel to claim the CAA title and landed an 11th seed in the NCAA Tournament's South Regional in Nashville.

In the end, it took a desperation heave from Maryland's Drew Nicholas for the Terps to escape one of the biggest upsets in tournament history. Blizzard racked up 15 points, four rebounds and four assists in his final game as a Seahawk and Goldsberry set an NCAA Tournament record with eight straight 3-pointers to delight a packed house at the Gaylord Entertainment Center.

# UNCW Men's Basketball NCAA Tournament History

## 2006 NCAA First Round

George Washington 88, UNCW 85 (OT) • March 16, 2006  
Greensboro Coliseum • Greensboro, N.C.

It started with an eye-opening run in the Black Coaches Association Invitational in remote Laramie, Wyoming, and ended with a thrilling overtime finish against George Washington in the NCAA Tournament. All told, the 2005-06 season was one of the most exciting ever for the Seahawks.

In what proved to be Brad Brownell's final season with the program, UNCW rallied behind four seniors and several emerging players to surprise CAA observers by tying for first place in the regular season and advancing to their fourth NCAA Tournament in seven years.

Led by senior playmaker John Goldsberry, the Seahawks opened the season by dispatching Butler, host Wyoming and Northwestern to win the BCA Invitational. UNCW kicked off its CAA slate with wins over William & Mary and VCU before the Christmas holiday and went into cruise control after the break, winning eight of nine games in a critical stretch and 10 of their last nine contests in the regular season.

Junior T.J. Carter then turned in a spectacular performance in the CAA Tournament to lead the Seahawks to their fourth CAA crown. He poured in 12 of his game-high 23 points in the final 2:51 of the championship game against Hofstra and added 13 rebounds en route to CAA Tournament MVP honors.

The Seahawks then collected a No. 9 seed in the NCAA Tournament and squared off against No. 8 George Washington at the Greensboro Coliseum. Brownell's club led by as many as 18 points, but couldn't hold n against the Colonials in a thrilling overtime clash.

## 2016 NCAA First Round

Duke 93, UNCW 85 • March 17, 2016  
Dunkin' Donuts Center • Providence, R.I.

UNCW's first trip to the Big Dance in 10 seasons sent a signal to the NCAA hoops followers across the land that the program was back atop the CAA after several years in exile.

The Seahawks, behind wily veteran guard Craig Ponder and newcomers Chris Flemmings and Denzel Ingram, went 14-4 during the regular season to tie for their second straight CAA regular season title and then ran the table in the CAA Tournament in Baltimore to lock up the club's fifth trip to the NCAA Tournament.

Flemmings was the catalyst for UNCW's stirring run in 2016. The walk-on transfer from Barton College averaged 16.2 points and 5.8 rebounds and was named CAA Tournament MVP after scoring 53 points in wins over Charleston, Northeastern and Hofstra at Royal Farms Arena.

The Seahawks entered the NCAA Tournament with a 25-7 record and a No. 13 seed against NCAA blue blood Duke, a No. 4 seed.

UNCW battled the Blue Devils tough, leading 43-40 at halftime, before Duke rallied for a 93-85 decision at the Dunkin' Donuts Center in Providence, R.I.

Grayson Allen and Marshall Plumlee scored 23 points apiece in the win for Duke. Allen added 10 rebounds and freshman forward Brandon Ingram poured in 20 points to give the Blue Devils three players with 20+ points. Ponder led the Seahawks with 22 points in his final game in a Seahawk uniform.

The UNCW-Duke game, which kicked off the 2016 NCAA Tournament, set an all-time NCAA Tournament record for a live streaming audience, racking up 5.5 million viewers.

# UNCW Men's Basketball NCAA Tournament History

## 2017 NCAA First Round Virginia 76, UNCW 71 • March 16, 2017 Amway Center • Orlando, Fla.

The best offensive season in UNCW history featured a record 29 wins and numerous team and individual records in Kevin Keatts' final season on the bench.

The Seahawks achieved back-to-back CAA championships after defeating the College of Charleston in the CAA Tournament's inaugural year at the North Charleston Coliseum. The impressive title run earned the Seahawks their sixth NCAA appearance and a matchup with Virginia of the ACC in Orlando, Fla.

UNCW bolted out to an 11-1 record and dominated the CAA during the regular season with a 15-3 record. UNCW closed at 29-6 overall and 13-1 at Trask Coliseum in a highly-successful campaign.

Sophomore guard C.J. Bryce anchored four players in double figures with 17.4 points per game and was complemented by senior guard Chris Flemmings (15.8), senior guard Denzel Ingram (14.6) and sophomore forward Devontae Cacok (12.3).

Bryce turned in an outstanding CAA Tournament, scoring 57 points over three games and was joined on the All-Tournament squad by Ingram and Cacok.

Cacok emerged as a force inside for the Seahawks. He racked up 13 double-doubles and led the nation in field goal percentage after connecting on 80 percent of his field goal attempts.

The Seahawks landed a No. 12 seed in the NCAA Tournament and led No. 5-seeded Virginia by as many as 15 points in the first half before the Cavaliers rallied down the stretch to avoid the upset in Orlando.
